Funding Opportunities

Dissertation Grant Awards from the Society for the Study of School Psychology (SSSP)

These awards are up to \$5,000 to promote excellence in research training in school psychology. Awards will be granted to high quality empirical studies that employ rigorous research methods and contribute to advancing the the scientific basis of school psychology.

The application deadline is **Thursday, March 9th, 2017.**

Summer Fellowship

Connecticut Institute for the Brain and Cognitive Sciences (CT IBACS)

3-month fully funded summer fellowship for graduate students working on topics related to the brain and cognitive sciences.

Fellows will attend a short grant-writing workshop at the start of the summer period, and will be expected to submit an application to the NSF GRFP, NRSA (pre- or post doctoral fellowship), or equivalent, in the fall.

Students who are not US citizens **are** eligible to apply. About 10-15 people will be chosen.
