Connecticut Institute for the Brain and Cognitive Sciences (CT IBACS)

3-month fully funded summer fellowship for graduate students working on topics related to the brain and cognitive sciences. Fellows will attend a short grant-writing workshop at the start of the summer period, and will be expected to submit an application to the NSF GRFP, NRSA (pre- or post doctoral fellowship), or equivalent, in the fall.
